## Kifowit Holding Workshop to Connect Residents With State Government

AURORA, Ill. – To provide residents with the latest news from the Legislature, state Rep. Stephanie Kifowit, D-Oswego, will be hosting a workshop on how to use the Illinois General Assembly’s official website on Thursday, October 15 from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Aurora Public Library, located at 555 S. Eola Rd. in Aurora.

“People want to be involved in the political process, but they don’t always know where to find information and how to stay up-to-date,” Kifowit said. “The General Assembly website is an invaluable resource, and I want to make sure residents know how to utilize it.”

Kifowit will be joined by Samantha Marcum, District Director from state Sen. Jennifer Bertino-Tarrant’s office, and together, they will teach the public how to maneuver through the system. Residents are encouraged to bring Wi-Fi compatible smart phones, tablets or laptops to the interactive event, on which they will learn how to follow live session and committee meetings, track legislation and votes, comment on current legislation proposals and find their district official’s contact information. Wi-Fi will be provided by the Aurora Public Library.

“This workshop will teach residents how to use the website to stay connected with their district officials and have the information to stay involved,” Kifowit said. “Having the public more involved with state government will make officials more accountable and better at serving the people they represent.”
