Veterans Day is observed November 11th. The federal holiday coincides with Armistice Day and Remembrance Day, which marks World War I. These observances reflect the end of significant hostilities at the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918 when the Armistice with Germany took effect.

This year, the City of Aurora is honoring women Veterans and I along with over a dozen women Veterans will be leading the parade. Please join us on **Veterans Day, Thursday November 11th, 2021.**

The ceremony includes a military rifle salute by veteran organizations at **11:00 a.m.**, the exact time the armistice was signed that ended WWI.

I would love for you to come out and celebrate with us. Help us observe the day by attending the parade, another ceremony, or take a veteran you know out for a meal. Local business and employers can also participate by holding special events honoring veteran employees and customers.
